How to create a MyESC account?



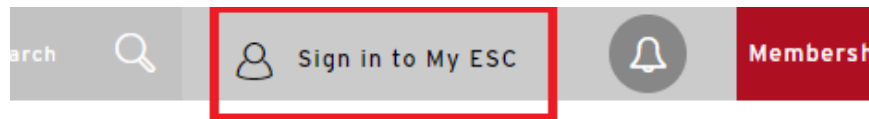
Why should I need a MyESC account?

Registering for EECC 2026 gives you access to the EECC preparatory course, which has many resources to help you prepare for your exam.


This course is only accessible with a valid MyESC account

Create your My ESC account

1. Go to ESC website: <https://www.escardio.org/>
2. On the top right, click on 'Sign in to My ESC'

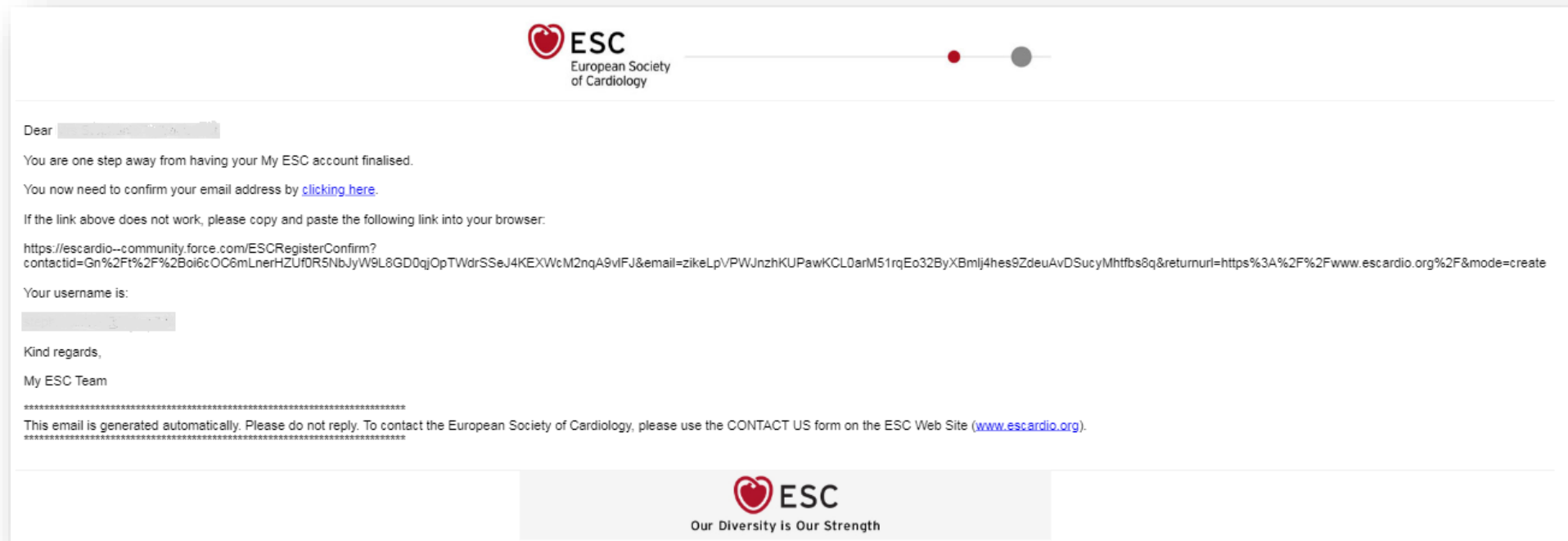
