Peri-Procedure

- Optimised peri-procedure practices
- Procedure planning that incorporates lifetime disease management and facilitates future THV-in-THV and coronary interventions

Post-Procedure

Standardised protocols for a speedy postprocedural recovery and ongoing patient care

- Standardised post-procedural care to facilitate nurse-led safe recovery and early mobilisation
- Consistent management of new conduction delays
- Safe and timely discharge home
- Regular communication with referring physicians and program administration

- In October, pilot launch of the TAVI Nurse **Leadership training in Europe** with a curriculum designed by European TAVI Nurse and Coordinator faculty in association with Vancouver faculty
- On 27 November, global faculty released evolution of Edwards Benchmark program in Europe - now with 10 evidence-based Best Practices

- 30-day outcomes of BENCHMARK Registry data presented at EuroPCR late-breaking clinical data session on 17th May³
- BENCHMARK practices reduce mean hospital length of stay and average intensive care usage[‡], without compromising patient safety
- >85 European centres certified by the Edwards Benchmark program team


